

# **ATTENTION ROSELLE RESIDENTS**

**STARTING ON MONDAY, APRIL 2, 2007**

**VEGETATIVE WASTE PICK-UP STARTS  
AND  
ENDS OCTOBER 26, 2007**

**Vegetative Waste** is picked up on the 1<sup>st</sup> trash collection day of the week. This includes branches, grass clippings, garden debris and leaves. These items can be placed in the brown bio-degradable paper bags, trash containers not larger than 35 gallons, not to exceed 50 pounds in weight. **Branches** must be cut/tied-up in 4' lengths bundles and placed at the curb the night before scheduled pick-up after 6:00 p.m. Any tree branches/stumps, tree logs, larger than 4" in diameter must call Public Works for a scheduled pick-up and (still must be 4' lengths and stacked neatly at curb). **DO NOT PLACE AT CURB**, without calling for an appointment 1<sup>st</sup>, or you will be issued a summons.

**NO PLASTIC BAGS** can be used, only bio-degradable brown papers bags that can be composted at the NJ DEP Approved site.

**PLEASE REMEMBER!** THE VEGETATIVE TRUCK IS A DIFFERENT TRUCK THEN THE NORMAL TRASH VEHICLES. ALSO, IF YOUR SCHEDULED PICK-UP FALLS ON A HOLIDAY, YOUR VEGETATIVE WASTE WILL BE PICKED-UP THE FOLLOWING WEEK.
