

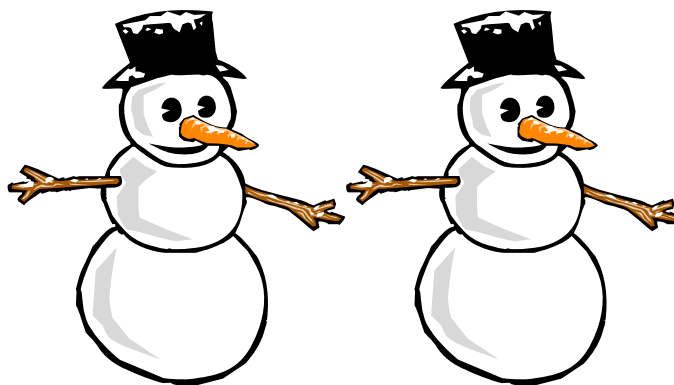
BOROUGH OF ROSELLE

The Borough of Roselle Department of Public Works is trying hard to keep the roads open and clear of snow. Your help is needed. There are a few simple steps that you can take as a good citizen that will enable the work crews to do their job in an effective manner.

Remember, emergencies and clearing the roads for emergency vehicles come first we then try to return to normal operations.

At the first sign of snow fall:

- **PLEASE** remove your vehicle from the road. If you do not have room in your driveway or no driveway at all, ask a neighbor for assistance and use of their driveway.
- Refrain from shoveling your driveway and apron until the plow has completed at least two passes along the roadside on your street.
- Try not to call the Department of Public Works or Police Department to find out if the department is out plowing snow, this will allow extreme emergencies to get through.
- Do not place snow back into the street either by shoveling or by use of snow blower.
- Refrain from driving unless absolutely necessary.
- Dead End, Cul-de-sac or Narrow streets, Please don't park in streets.
- Please do not leave or park your vehicle in the street. It only slows the response time to get streets cleared and salted.
