Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and **BRING WITH YOU:**

1. A valid driver's license.
2. A high school diploma or GED; and must provide high school transcript in sealed envelope from the high school you attended, or GED transcript.
3. Military veterans must provide a copy of their DD-214
