Roselle Residents May Notice a Slight Taste or Smell in Tap Water

As part of an annual maintenance program for its water distribution system, New Jersey American Water will temporarily change the water treatment process from a chloramine (combined) residual to free chlorine residual at the company's Raritan-Millstone and Canal Road Surface Water Treatment plants. These plants serve Roselle.

The temporary treatment process began on Monday, February 11 and will continue until the end of April. Customers may notice a slight taste and smell of chlorine in the tap water. This is normal and will only be temporary until the system maintenance is complete. Customers who wish to reduce the taste of chlorine can place water in an uncovered glass container in the refrigerator overnight to help dissipate chlorine.
