

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BOROUGH OF ROSELLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2415-11**

**AMENDMENT TO BOROUGH OF ROSELLE CODE: PART II: GENERAL
LEGISLATION; ARTICLE IV-SCHEDULES, SECTION 113-67-
“SCHEDULE XXII: BUS STOPS”**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Roselle, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 113-67 “Schedule XXII: Bus Stops” of Article IV- Chapter 113-Schedules of the Borough Code is amended by deleting the following:

Section 2. Section 113-67 “Schedule XXII: Bus Stops” of Article IV- Chapter 113-Schedules of the Borough Code is amended by adding the following:

Section 3. That the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Roselle will enforce the needed traffic regulations governing the aforementioned bus stop locations and provide the necessary police security to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

Section 4. If any portion or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, for any reason, be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of the ordinance which is hereby declared to be severable.

Section 5. All ordinances or part of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided at law.
